Demolition Update

You may not see much going on but our asbestos removal works are still ongoing and are continuing to go well. An Independent Analyst continues to monitor our asbestos removal operations and is satisfied that the areas are clear of asbestos and air clearance certificates are still being issued.

You will soon see mast climbers being erected onto the outside of the building. These are for the removal of the external asbestos panels. To give local people further reassurance, GHA and NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde are working towards providing further independent asbestos monitoring services during the external asbestos removal operations. Considerate Constructors Scheme

Earlier in the year Safedem enrolled in the Considerate Constructors Scheme. The scheme is a national initiative and is concerned about any area of construction activity that may have a direct impact on the image of the industry as a whole. The main areas of concern focus on the environment, the work force and the general public. All sites enrolled in this scheme are given points based on an 8 point code of practice which includes considerate, environment, cleanliness, good neighbour, respectful, safe, responsible and accountable. We scored 32 points out of a possible 40 points which rates the site as a very good site. That's a great start but we aim to improve on this score.
