Red Road Environment Consultation – 24th January 2pm to 8pm.

Where – Alive and Kicking, 94 Red Road

The Glasgow Housing Association (GHA) want to hear your views and ideas for how to improve and develop the environment on and around Red Road once demolitions are complete. GHA are looking for your suggestions on what land improvements should be included and what are your priorities for the environmental regeneration. For example what are your ideas for using the land to provide health, sport, education, wildlife and path networks; GHA want to hear your ideas.

GHA is holding a Public Consultation Event at the Alive and Kicking Gym at 94 Red Road on Thursday the 24th of January 2013.

To ensure you get your voice heard GHA staff will be there from 2:00pm until 8:00pm, answering your questions and asking for your recommendations. Staff will provide maps and drawings for you to add your own views to.

GHA, with support from Glasgow City Council and the Forestry Commission will take your suggestions and develop an 'Environmental Master Plan' based on what you want to see happen. This will be the basis for how the area might look and be used - going into the future.
